### C.R.F.U. ADOPT COLLEGE GAME.

Ottawa, Jan. 14.—(Special.)—The Canadian Rugby Football Union, at its annual meeting here to-day, showed the way for the consolidation of the playing rules of the three unions under its jurisdiction by adopting for the annual Canadian championship contests the rules and regulations of the Intercollegiate Rugby Football Union, subject to several changes, a few of them important and others of a minor character. That it was a most important move football men will agree, and the change from present conditions was only brought about after several hours of discussion on the part of the delegates present. The motion which finally brought about the adoption of the intercollegiate rules originated with Dr. Etherington of Queen's. Frank D. Woodworth of Toronto, speaking for the Ontario Union, said that that body, of which he was Secretary, would be quite willing to play in the finals under the new rules.
