CANADIAN FOOTBALL LEAGUE

RULE CHANGES FOR 1962

1. A defending player will be allowed to intercept a forward pass in his own end zone and run the ball out, picking up blockers on the way.
2. Interior linemen will be frozen in their positions once they are taken--a move designed to stop them from intentionally drawing opposing players offside. The rule further restricts the linemen's head and arm movements up to the time the ball is snapped and will provide penalties where these movements are intended to influence the actions of opposing linemen.
3. A pass will be ruled completed even if touched previously by another eligible receiver. The completed pass will be taken back to the point where it was first touched.

(Note: In the first rule change, if the interceptor is tackled behind his own goal line, no point will be awarded and the ball will be put on the 10-yard line. If a player is tackled anywhere from his goal line to his own nine-yard line, the team in possession of the ball will receive a first down at the point where the tackle occurs.)

BLUE BOMBER COACHING STAFF

BUD GRANT

HEAD COACH

Three Grey Cup championships in his five years as coach of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers earned Harry Peter (Bud) Grant a brand new five-year contract this season. Bud took over the reins of the Bombers at the start of the 1957 season and immediately proceeded to pilot the Big Blue to the incredible string of four first and one second-place finish which brought Winnipeg four Western and three National titles. His lone second-place team (1957), along with his 1960 club, were his top winners--14 wins and two losses in 16 league games. Bud's appointment as coach followed a fine career as a player in both the Western league in Canada and the National Football League in the United States. Born in Superior, Wisconsin, on May 20th, 1927, Bud went to the University of Minnesota, where he played football, basketball and baseball. After graduation, he played two seasons with Minneapolis Lakes professional basketball team. He later switched to pro football with the Philadelphia Eagles. He joined the Bombers as an offensive end in 1953. He led the WFLU in pass receiving in 1953, '54 and '56 and also was selected the All-Stars in those same years. Although having no coaching experience, Bud was named coach of the Bombers in 1957, retiring as a player. Now, he is a year-round resident of Winnipeg. Bud and wife Pat and their five children live in suburban Tuxedo.

JOE ZALESKI

ASSISTANT COACH - BACKFIELD

Joe has been Grant's right-hand man since 1958, following a two-year coaching career with the Sarnia Golden Bears. His ability to get along with all concerned has contributed greatly to Joe's success as a backfield coach with Winnipeg. Born in Kensington, Pa., on March 19, 1927, Joe played his college football at the University of Dayton at Dayton, Ohio. He came to Winnipeg in 1952, and shared the quarterbacking duties with Jack Jacobs for three years. In 1955, he played with the Montreal Alouettes and then went to Sarnia. The likeable sales representative for Calvert's in the off-season, is the proud father of four girls.

JOHN MICHELS

ASSISTANT COACH - LINE

The youngest member of the three-man coaching staff, John was Grant's choice for the line coaching job in 1959 when Wayne Robinson left to become head coach at Vancouver. A tough task-master, John has whipped the Bomber lines into the best in the country. Born in Philadelphia on February 15, 1931, John received his early education in the Quaker City, then went to the University of Tennessee, earning three letters. A guard, he was All-American in 1952. He joined the Philadelphia Eagles in 1953; spent two years in the Army; rejoined the Eagles in 1956. John came to Winnipeg in 1957, but he left the playing ranks for a line-coaching job in 1958 at Texas A & M. He returned to the Bombers as line coach the next season. John is married and has four children.

JIM AUSLEY

GENERAL MANAGER

Outstanding among successful football executives, Jim has played a major part in Bombers' reign at the top of Canadian football. He joined the Bomber organization as Head Trainer 10 years ago, and was elevated to the General Manager's job in 1958. Although the General-Manager has to be in the background as far as the fans are concerned, Jim has to work closely with the executive, the coaches, the news media, and the players--even to a point of being a "Father Confessor." As a result, Ausley has built up an efficient office staff and operation. Born in Waco, Texas, on October 19th, 1925, he received his early education in Houston. After a three-year stint as a physical training instructor in the Air Force, he picked up his education at the University of Houston, graduating in 1948. 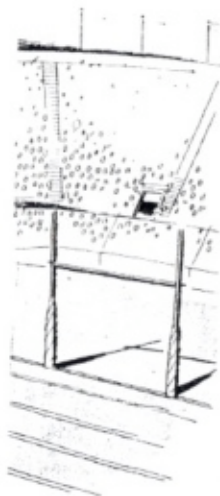

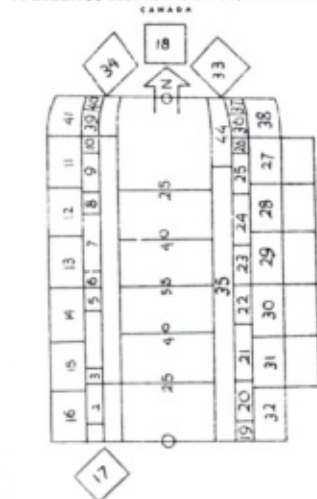
