

O.R.F.U. CHAMPIONS PROTEST ARGOS' WIN

CLAIM REFEREE GALL ERRED IN AWARDING UNEARN- ED TRY

Toronto O. R. F. U. champions, beaten in the Dominion series semi-finals on Saturday, have protested to the Canadian Union that Referee Gall erred when he ruled that a touchdown scored by Torontos in the third period was unearned. The Torontos will ask that the matter be referred to the Intercollegiate Union Rules Commission for decision, but it is doubtful whether the Canadian Union will consent to have a commission of one of its members overrule the decision of the Canadian Union President made on the field of play.

In case Torontos win their protest, the game will likely be ordered replayed, as Argonauts cannot be accused of making the decision, and would have used different tactics had an earned try been awarded. As a matter of plain fact they were in position to score several more points by the kicking route in the final period, and would have done so instead of attempting to score touchdowns had they needed the points.
