RULE CHANGES FOR 1963

- On scrimmage plays, except punts, field goal attempts or place kick attempts for point after touchdown:

- Five players of the wingline shall be identified as ineligible pass receivers.
- Two players of the wingline shall be identified as ends.
- The remaining five players shall be identified as backfielders.

(Note--For purposes of the CFL, players shall be identified by numbering as follows:

CENTRES	- 40 to 49 -	INELIGIBLE RECEIVERS
GUARDS	- 50 to 59 -	INELIGIBLE RECEIVERS
TACKLES	- 60 to 69 -	INELIGIBLE RECEIVERS
ENDS	- 70 to 79 -	
BACKFIELDERS	- 1 to 39 -	

- a-Players of the ATTACKING SIDE on a forward pass play may interfere with their opponents anywhere up to a line one yard in advance of the line of scrimmage.

b-Interference on a forward pass play by a player of the attacking team shall be ruled:

i-If in the area of the destination of the pass--
Penalty--Loss of ball at point of interference.

ii-If NOT in the area of the destination of the pass--
Penalty--12D L15, 3D if YG. L15 DR. 3D YNG LB at PLS.

EXCEPT THAT

c-Where a forward pass play fails to cross the line of scrimmage (Shovel Pass) but is legally completed or incompleted by the Attacking Team, the play shall be considered as a ball-carrying play for purposes of interference and all players who were on the wingline at the instant the ball was snapped shall be eligible to interfere from dead-line to deal-line. This shall include the privileged backfielders.

GORD MACKIE

TRAINER

One of the best "tape" men in the country, Gord is credited with keeping many of the Bombers in one piece for their Grey Cup victory last year. Born in Winnipeg in 1922, he received his early schooling here then completed his education on Montreal. He was an outstanding boxer while serving in the Canadian Navy from 1940-45. His service credits enabled him to take a physiotherapy course in Montreal, and he received his degree in 1949. In succeeding years, he ran a health club in Winnipeg; became a wrestling and boxing promoter; was assistant trainer at West Point; appointed Canada's boxing coach for the 1954 British Empire Games although he never went to the Games because of prior commitments; was trainer for the Winnipeg Warriors pro hockey team and the Winnipeg Goldeyes Baseball Club. Took over as trainer for the Bombers in 1958 when Jim Ausley was elevated to General-Manager. Gordie is married and has four children.

BOB JONES

EQUIPMENT MANAGER

One of the unsung heroes in the Winnipeg Football Club's success, Bob is the real veteran of the organization--having started with the team as a water boy in 1939. At that time it was part of his job to look after certain equipment. Now it is a fulltime chore, and requires a fulltime assistant (Pop Varnes). Born in Winnipeg, Bob was educated in local schools but never played football even at the minor level. He is single.

ASH, RAY

GUARD - LINEBACKER 26 5-11 225 Fourth Year. A native of Timmins, Ontario, joined the Bombers in 1960. Started football with Gordon Bell High School in Winnipeg then played for the Winnipeg Junior Rods, the Intermediate St. Vital Bulldogs, the senior Sarnia Golden Bears and the Saskatchewan Roughriders. Holds distinction of being on championship teams at three levels--Junior Rods, Intermediate Bulldogs and pro Bombers.

BRUZELL, JACK

CENTRE - DEFENSIVE END 25 6-3 250 Fifth Year. Born in Winnipeg. Educated at Daniel McIntyre Collegiate. Played football, basketball and also ardent curler. A graduate of the Winnipeg Junior Rods.

BURKHOLDER, DAVE

TACKLE - LINEBACKER 26 6-1 225 Sixth Year. Been at a linebacker post since becoming a Bomber in 1958. Always high in award balloting and three time WFC All-Star. Played outstanding game in 1962 Grey Cup although hampered by a severe charley-horse. Born in Minneapolis. Outstanding lineman with the University of Minnesota Gophers. Single. Stock-broker in the off-season.

DELVEAUX, JACK

FULLBACK - LINEBACKER 26 6-1 220 Fifth Year. Considered one of the greatest defensive players never named to a WFC All-Star berth since his arrival in 1959. Played defensive end last year but likely will go back to his linebacking slot this year. A smashing tackler and fierce competitor. Also may handle the punting chores due to the retirement of Charlie Shepard. Born in Chicago. Played at the University of Illinois and with the New York Giants of the NFL. Married.

DUXMAN, GEORGE

CENTRE - LINEBACKER 33 6-1 220 Ninth Year. Oldest player on the team at 33. Has been regular centre since joined the club in 1955. An honest performer. Born in Winnipeg. Earned three letters in football at the University of Portland. Named to WFC All-Stars as centre once. Married.

FUNSTON, FARRELL END - LINEBACKER 27 6-2 208 Fifth Year. Leading pass receiver in the West in 1961 when named to All-Star team, but slowed by injuries last year. Made the big play which put Bombers into Grey Cup when he recovered a last-play fumble in Calgary's end zone for the game-winning TD. Born in Los Angeles. Earned 4 letters in football at College of Pacific. Year-round resident of Winnipeg. Married.

GRAY, HERB

GUARD - DEFENSIVE END 29 6-2 218 Eighth Year. Perennial All-Star. Last year named with WFC selections for sixth time since joining Bombers in 1956. Won Schenley Award for Top Lineman in Canada in 1960. Born in Baytown, Texas. Earned 4 letters in football at the University of Texas. Chosen All-American. Named permanent captain of the Longhorns in 1955. Bomber defensive captain. Married.

HAGBERG, ROGER

FULLBACK - LINEBACKER 24 6-2 215 Third Year. Fifth leading rusher in the WFC last year. Picked up 856 yards on 157 carries for 5.4 average. Operated from both halfback and fullback positions last season. Scored six touchdowns. Born in Winnebago, Minn., of Swedish parents. Won 3 letters in football at the University of Minnesota. Married.

HAMELIN, ROGER

TACKLE - TACKLE 22 6-2 235 Third Year. Played standout game in 1962 Grey Cup. Improving each year since joined Bombers in 1961. Played high school football at St. Paul's College in Winnipeg and junior with the Weston Wildcats. Single.

HOLLIS, WILBURN

HALFBACK 22 6-1/2 215 Quarterback from Iowa. Great college quarterback obtained from New York Giants. Will play halfback for Bombers. From Boys Town, Neb.

JAMES, GERRY

FULLBACK 28 5-11 190 Eleventh Year. Second leading scorer in WFC last year with 116 points on 5 TDs, season record 41 converts and 12 field goals, and 9 singles. Averaged 4.1 yards on net gain of 345 yards in 84 attempts. Runnerup in scoring in 1961 and scored 13 points in Bombers' Grey Cup win that year. Won WFC scoring twice and holds record of most TDs in one season (19). Won Schenley award twice as Most Valuable Canadian player. Twice named to WFC All-Stars. Born in Regina. Son of former football great Eddie (Dynamite) James who was recently named to Hall of Fame. Played high school football at Kelvin in Winnipeg. Played pro hockey with Toronto Maple Leafs in 1950s. Married.

JANZEN, HENRY

HALFBACK - DEFENSIVE HALF 23 5-10 185 Fifth Year. Made four interceptions for 73 yards and one TD last year. Fourth in kickoff returns and fifth in punt returns in 1962. Previous season led the WFC in most yards on runback of punts (194) and best average runback (7.3). Graduate of Junior Weston Wildcats. Single.

JONES, JERRY

FULLBACK - LINEBACKER 29 6-1 201 First Year. Graduate of the University of Minnesota. Strong, slashing runner. Carried 98 times for 462 yards and 4.6 average last year. Caught 8 passes for 55 yards. Punted 21 times for 782 yards and 37.7 average.

KOVACS, KEN

END 6-0 185 First Year. Former Bomber equipment assistant. Last year with Junior St. James Rods. Attended rookie camp this season.

LATOURELLE, RON

HALFBACK - DEFENSIVE HALF 29 5-8 180 Ninth Year. Runner-up in Punt returns last year with 384 yards. Excelled in 1961 Grey Cup with brilliant runbacks and fill-in job at offensive half due to injuries to regulars. Born in Winnipeg. Graduate of Junior Winnipeg Rods.

LEDYARD, HAL

QUARTERBACK - DEFENSIVE HALF 30 5-11 190 Third Year. Excellent backup man for first-stringer Kenny Ploen since joining Bombers in 1961. Came off bench in 1962 Grey Cup to engineer Bombers first TD. Wound up the game with 13 completions of 18 passes for 190 yards. During season completed 41 of 84 passes for 633 yards and 5 TDs. Formerly with the University of Chattanooga, San Francisco, Ottawa, and Sarnia. Now a Canadian. Born in Montgomery, Ala. Married.

LEWIS, LEO HALFBACK - DEFENSIVE HALF 30 5-10 196 Eighth Year. Outstanding player in Bombers' 1962 Grey Cup victory. Named to WFC All-Stars last year. His fifth time. Fourth in league rushing last season with 865 yards on 134 carries for 6.4 average. Sixth in scoring with 11 TDs. Six on passes. Born in Des Moines, Iowa. Attended Lincoln College. 4 letters in football. AP Little All-American selection in 1953-54. Signed three-year contract last season. Married.

LOCKE, ROGER END - END 21 6-3 218 First Year. A sure-handed pass receiver and strong runner. Good blocker. Vicious tackler. Last year caught 12 passes for 215 yards and 2 TDs. Eighth draft choice of San Francisco of NFL and 3rd of Oakland Raiders of AFL.

LUINING, CEC CENTRE - DEFENSIVE END 30 6-1 215 Tenth Year. Steady performer at defensive end. Born in Winnipeg. Played soccer, basketball and football at Daniel McIntyre High School. Graduate of Intermediate Winnipeg Rams. Married.

MILLER, NICK FULLBACK - DEFENSIVE HALF 30 6-1 195 Tenth Year. Regular on Bomber defensive unit. Born in St. Boniface. Attended St. John's Tech. Played football with Junior Winnipeg Light Infantry and Intermediate Rams. Single.

MONTEITH, IAN FULLBACK - LINEBACKER 20 6-1 200 First Year. Picked up by Bombers in Canadian college draft from McGill University. Born in London, Ont. Never had a fumble in three years with the Redmen. Used also as a punter, place-kicker and passer. Plays baseball, hockey and basketball and was Intercollegiate shot-put champion in 1962.

PALMER, BRIAN QUARTERBACK - DEFENSIVE HALF 23 5-10 180 First Year. Born in Winnipeg where he played football with Daniel McIntyre in High School loop. Won championship in 1957. Reserve quarterback at the University of Kansas in 1962. Completed 13 passes for 203 yards and 2 TDs. Quit the Kansas training camp this spring. Played minor football here with Junior Rods and attended the Bomber camp in 1959. Also used as punter.

PATRICK, STEVE TACKLE - MIDDLE GUARD 31 6-1 230 Twelfth Year. Co-Captain of the Bombers with Gray. Sound performer. Uses experience to beat opponents. WFC All-Star twice. Most Valuable Canadian on Bombers in 1957. Played junior with W.L.I. Born in Glenella, Man. Married.

PIPER, CORNEL GUARD - TACKLE 26 6-1 235 Seventh Year. Played outstanding game in 1962 Grey Cup after being hampered by a variety of injuries during regular season. WFC All-Star in 1961. Most Valuable Canadian on Bombers in 1960. Born in Ardmore, Alta. Played with Junior Winnipeg Rods in 1956 championship year. Still of junior age when joined Bombers. Single.

PITTS, ERNIE END - DEFENSIVE HALF 28 6-2 192 Seventh Year. Ranked second in WFC pass-receiving last year, with 62 receptions of 72 throws for 865 yards, an 86 percentage, and 8 TDs.

PIRKLE, MIKE END - END 22 6-1 1/2 220 First Year. A strong two-way end from North Texas State. Hard tackler. Co-captain on 1962 NTS team. Started all games with North Texas in his last two years after serving on the Alternate squad as a sophomore. Twice honorable mention to All-Conference.

PITTS, ERNIE END - DEFENSIVE HALF 28 6-2 192 Seventh Year. Ranked second in WFC pass-receiving last year, with 62 receptions of 72 throws for 865 yards, an 86 percentage, and 8 TDs. Tied for 8th place in scoring with 9 TDs. His ninth came on a recovery of an opposition fumble. Also was runner-up in pass-catching in 1961. Holds two WFC pass-receiving records and shares another. All came in 1959 -- 16 TDs from passes in one season; most yards on passes, 1126; and tied Bud Grant (then a Bomber end) in most passes caught (68) in one season. WFL All-Star three times. Born in Aliquippa, Penn. Attended University of Denver. Named to several All-American squads. Married.

PLOEN, KEN QUARTERBACK - SAFETY 28 6-1 185 Seventh Year. Considered the best two-way quarterback in Canada. Ploen set new WFC records last year with a 65.8 completion percentage and only four passes intercepted. Was good on 137 passes in 208 attempts for 2097 yards (4th in league) and 17 TDs. Played standout game at safety in 1962 Grey Cup and teamed with Ledyard at quarterback to beat Hamilton. Scored Winnipeg TD in 1961 Grey Cup win and named game's MVP. Twice named to WFC All-Stars. Quarterbacked Bombers to Canadian championships in 1959, 1961 and 1962 and was member of 1958 winning team. Born in Lost Nation, Iowa. Attended University of Iowa. Led Hawkeyes to Rose Bowl title in January 1957. Named All-American. Year-round resident of Winnipeg. Married.

RAIMEY, DAVE HALFBACK - 22 5-10 195 First Year. Leading score at the University of Michigan the last two years. Wolverines won only two games last year. Raimey scored 5 TDs. Carried 124 times for 385 yards. Caught 11 passes for 45 yards and 4.1 average. Scored 36 points in 1960 and 48 in 1961. Outstanding track star--broad jump, low hurdles and sprints. Born in Dayton.

RAUHAUS, NORM END - SAFETY 27 6-1 195 Eighth Year. Steady deep defensive man. Picked up one fumble and one interception last year. 1961 WFC All-Star at defensive half. Outstanding Canadian on Bombers in 1961. Rookie of the year in 1956. Born in Winnipeg. Played football at Kelvin High School and with Weston Wildcats Junior team.

RIGNEY, FRANK TACKLE - TACKLE 27 6-4 233 Sixth Year. Last season named to WFC All-Stars for fourth time. Named Canada's outstanding lineman in 1961 and won Becket-DeMarco trophy for 2nd straight year. Born in East St. Louis, Ill. Attended the University of Iowa. Married.

ROWLAND, GORD HALF - LINEBACKER 32 5-10 175 Tenth Year. Named to WFC All-Stars last year for fifth time as a corner linebacker. Voted the West's top Canadian player in 1958 but lost in the Schenley voting to Hamilton's Ron Howell. Missed 1962 Grey Cup due to torn ligaments. Off-season operation a success. Holds WFC record for longest kickoff (99 yards); leads Bombers in individual lifetime interceptions (31) and lifetime punt returns--287 returns for 2217 yards and 7.7 average. Born in Montreal. Played with Montreal intermediate Orfuns. Married.

SAVOIE, ROGER TACKLE - TACKLE 30 6-1 230 Thirteenth Year. Veteran of the club in point of service. Named to WFC All-Stars as defensive tackle in 1962. Born in St. Boniface. Played with Junior Winnipeg Rods. Married.

SHANSKI, JOHN HALFBACK - 22 5-8 180 First Year. All-Star halfback with the University of Manitoba Bisons last year. Drafted by Bombers No. 2. Chosen as U of M's Athlete of the Year for second successive year. Played goal for Bison hockey team. Born in Winnipeg. Played juvenile football with Hawkeyes, and Rods Junior Club. Attended Bomber rookie camp the last three seasons.

THOMAS, NEIL TACKLE - TACKLE 23 6-1 250 Second Year. Gave Bombers valuable bench strength in 1962 his first year with the club as he ranked as a non-import because his father is a Canadian citizen. Played his football at Hillsdale College in Michigan. Selected All-Conference tackle in 1960 and '61. Heavyweight wrestler in off-season.

On offence, completed three of five passes for 44 yards; picked up 49 yards on two carries rushing; and scored 13 points on 2 TDs and a single. Also handled some punting chores. Born in Chicago. Earned 3 letters in football at Northwestern University. Married.

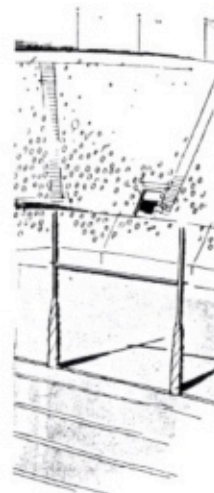

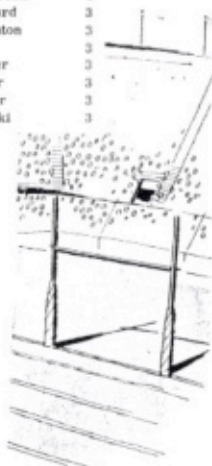

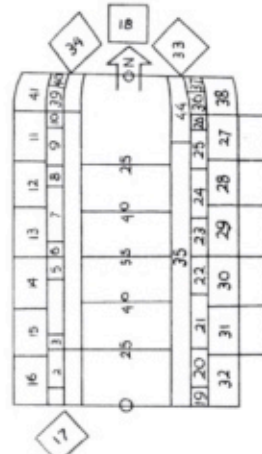
