WESTERN CONFERENCE TROPHY WINNERS

JEFF NICKLIN MEMORIAL TROPHY

This trophy each year goes to the player adjudged to be the most valuable to his team. Selection is made by 27 sportswriters and broadcasters who cover the WFC games during the season. The trophy was first put up for competition in 1946 and was donated to the WFC by officers and men of Lt. Col. Jeff Nicklin's paratroop battalion of the Second World War. Nicklin was killed in action March 24, 1945. Nicklin played for Winnipeg in the late '30s.

SCHENLEY AWARDS

The Schenley Awards were started in 1953. During that time 30 individual awards in the three classifications: (1) Most Outstanding Player, (2) Top Canadian Player and (3) Top Lineman of the Year, have been awarded. Edmonton leads with 8 winners followed by Ottawa with 6, Montreal with 5, Winnipeg with 4, Calgary and Hamilton, each with 3, and B.C. Lions with 1. No Toronto or Saskatchewan player has ever won a Schenley Award.

GREY CUP SCORES

The Grey Cup was first put up for competition in 1909 and was won by the University of Toronto. There have been 51 winners. Toronto Argonauts lead with 10 wins, Hamilton Tiger-Cats 8, Winnipeg Blue Bombers 7. The B.C. Lions and Saskatchewan Roughriders have not won a Grey Cup. In the 37 East-West classics since the first game in 1921, the East has triumphed 26 times. However, in the last 16 games, the scoreboard reads: West 9, East 7, and the West has won 7 of the last 10 Classics.
